Equally, between Bishop arriving in England on Saturday May 8 and the Benson and Hedges match against Middlesex, the following Tuesday May 11, his fitness, or otherwise, should have been established.

Once Bishop played against Middlesex any possibility that Derbyshire might recruit an overseas substitute for the season was gone. Now even the hope of him playing in the one-day cups has receded.

Ian Bishop is a likeable and responsible individual, whose intention would not be to cause problems for his adopted county. He has too much respect for his playing colleagues to attempt to play cricket on a false premise It is unlikely that he would be aware of the exact nature

Like many overseas stars and a few English players,
