JAN OF THE MOMENT!

NEWLY promoted **UTTOXETER** have notched their first win of the Burton Tiles Premier Division season thanks to a stunning all round display by Jan Kasperowicz against **HILTON**.

Uttoxeter batted first at the Racecourse and it was Kasperowicz's battling knock of 73 that provided the backbone to a total of 167 all out in 44.2 overs.

Skipper Alan Barber took four wickets for the visitors and it was his form with the bat that threatened to carry Hilton to victory.

Barber made 62 before he was caught and bowled by Michael Hodgkinson and then Kasperowicz took over to finish with 5-47 as Hilton slumped from 105-2 to 145 all out.

BARTON grabbed the league leadership by toppling previous pacesetters **IND COOPE** at Efflinch Lane.

The home team's innings got off to a flying start with Nick Tomlinson and Mike Hunter producing an opening stand of 67. Ian Mitchell helped to keep up the good work as he and Hunter took the score on to 149 before Daryl Scott made Ind Coope's next breakthrough.

Barton sacrificed wickets cheaply in the chase for quick runs, but in conditions still favouring the bowlers a score of 195-5 was always going to be difficult to overhaul.

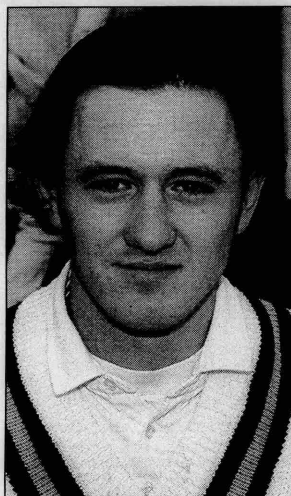
Ind Coope quickly lost openers Paul Green and Graeme Jones, but a century partnership between Mick McGuinness and Richard Jones threatened to sweep the visitors to victory.

The pair fell in quick succession, however, and a three-wicket burst by Nick Warr effectively put paid to Ind Coope, who fell 41 runs short of their target.

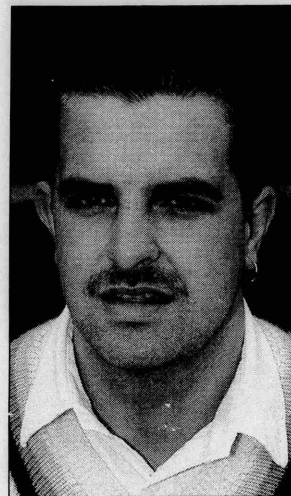
TUTBURY kicked themselves after squandering a glorious opportunity of a famous victory against champions **ALREWAS**.

The powerful Alrewas batting line-up was ripped apart by the bowling of Nick Miller who bowled unchanged to claim 7-37.

Needing only 110 for victory, Tutbury recovered from a shaky start and a memorable win looked theirs for the taking until spin king Steve Broderick removed top scorer Kevin Chadwick with the score at 100.

Suddenly the home team faltered and Broderick and Duane Whiteside delivered more blows as the innings closed on 104-9.

Foreign stars Rashid Latif and Owen Birch returned from sunny climes to help their teams to victory.

Latif, fresh from skipping Pakistan against South Africa, notched 35 as **MARCHINGTON** edged to a 14-run victory at **HAMMERWICH**.

Birch (48) and Andy Hall (64 not out) were the principal runmakers for **DRAYCOTT & HANBURY** as they snatched a four-wicket win at **BURTON**, for whom Anthony Thompson cracked a half century.

RELEGATED Trentside enjoyed sweet revenge by rolling over Hilton in the first round of the Breweries Cup.

HILTON replaced the Branstons side in the Burton Tiles Premier Division but were not strong enough to take the honours at **TRENTSIDE** who batted first to blaze 205-8 with the visitors limping to 136 all out.

Pete Stokes' 93 proved to be the mainstay of the innings with Steve Tivey and Colin Wood contributing 22 apiece in the face of a Hilton bowling attack spearheaded by Alan Barber's 5-29 from 9.6 overs.

After tea Trentside's Mark Stubbs cut Hilton apart, taking 5-24 as Hilton collapsed with only Pete Laban (55) making any dent in the attack.
