## Dunstall claim derby honours

## Hughes a clever boy

**DUNSTALL** grabbed the honours in a closely-fought Derbyshire County League Premier Division 2 game with local rivals Lullington Park.

Visiting seamer Steve Scrimshaw was at his most accurate on a wicket that offered encouragement throughout to the bowlers and batsmen experienced difficulty forcing the pace.

It was Scrimshaw who made the initial breakthrough as Garth Littlejohn perished to a leg-side catch by keeper Taylor to put Park in early trouble.

But, dogged batting by Mervyn Timbrell, in a lengthy stint at the crease, began to turn the game back towards the home side.

Finding the boundary four times, including a big six, he made a vital half-century before falling to Benstead's medium pace.

Howard Dytham, snapped up by Clewley for 12 gave Danny Spasic a scalp, but the returning force of Scrimshaw accounted for John Goodwin 14, and Tony Mudd for 11, as he returned 4-54 in 19 overs.

Skipper Dave Mudd made the breakthrough for the Park attack, Dave Firth, who with Jamie Benstead, had been tied down falling to a Tony Mudd catch in the covers.

But, Benstead, making 29, shared a solid second wicket stand with Spasic, whose a fighting half-century innings edged the visitors nearer to victory.

Spasic worked the ball well to stroke seven boundaries but was also quick to pick up vital singles to push the home side onto the defensive and he had made 53 before falling to a Mudd return catch.

Steve Docker's seam also brought as Martin Hall and Ian Graves fell cheaply, but the match was finally won for Dunstall by Rob Cooper who lofted the ball over fielders' heads to pick up four boundaries in an unbeaten 29 as Dunstall took the honours by five wickets with nine balls to spare.

● **DUNSTALL** second string proved successful against their neighbours with a five-wicket victory.

Lullington batted first and made a useful start with Johnny Ball and Dean Clark both playing well but some tight bowling helped peg the flow of runs until frustration overcame the middle order and leg-spinner Adam Fern picked a five-wicket haul.

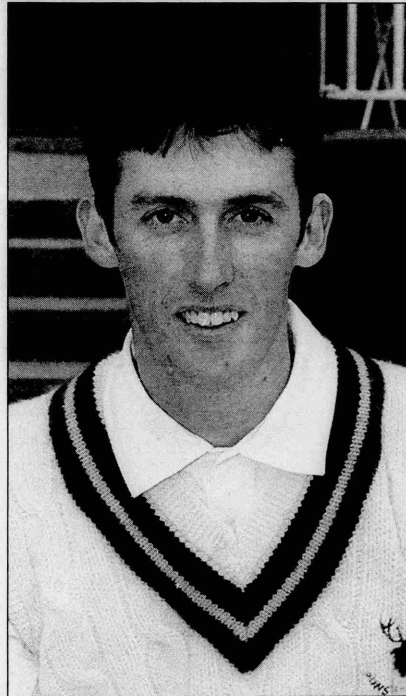
Dunstall's reply lacked fluidity as Phil Wallbank held the top order together until his dismissal to a good catch by Cooper and it was left to Captain Geoff Holliday (46 not) and Andy Easter to see the hosts through, Holliday finishing the game with a fine straight six off Green to give Dunstall their second win of the season.

● **PARK** third maintained their unbeaten run in Division 5b with an emphatic 125-run success over Castle Donington Town.

Teenager Steve Gough led the run-spree with a stylish 57, and he was well supported by Ian Shaw 24, and tail-ender John Oldfield, who whacked eight boundaries in his 39, as Park reached 183 in only 28 overs.

Castle Donington were always in trouble, with only Huntingford making any impression before becoming one of Ian Shaw's three victims.

Danny Gough claimed three cheap wickets and Oldfield two as the visitors were shot out for 58.

all out despite a battling 33 from Dave Taylor, but then Hughes got to work with a magnificent spell of 8-21, including his treble, to tumble out the visitors for 43.

**ROBIRCH PHOENIX** fared even worse at home to second-placed HOPWAS, with only skipper Adam Tomlinson managing double figures in a paltry total of 36.

Prolific wicket taker Phil Rainsford and fellow bowler Stuart Norchi shared the honours with the ball before their colleagues went on to claim a nine-wicket success that took them to second place in the table.

**TUTBURY 2ND** lead the table with a 100 per cent start, their latest victims being **ELDFORD**.

The home side made a fight of it and, despite a five-wicket haul by Tony Bentley, they reached a respectable total of 175 thanks to the efforts of Brian Found (49) and Mark Twomlow (35).

But it was all to no avail as Tutbury batted fluently in reply with Jez Redfern (60 not) and Jason Yates (47 not) guiding them to an eight-wicket win.

Star batsman of the day was **IND COOPE 2ND**'s John Thompson who crashed a magnificent 122 to help his team to 205-5 at home to **BARTON**. It was all too much for Barton to take as they crumbled to 102 all out, Phil Davies being the pick of the home attack with 3-8.

**DRAYCOTT & HANBURY 2ND** notched up their first win at home to **BURTON 2ND**. Steve Bayliss contributed 69 to a total of 189-9 and then Mark Lee claimed 4-22 as Burton struggled to 106 in reply.

**CENTRE SET**'s sluggish start to the campaign continued when they lost at home to **KINGS BROMLEY**. They could manage only 107-8 and John Woodburn's unbeaten half century helped the visitors to a four-wicket success.
