## Burton Tiles Division Two

## Dytham's knock simply majestic

HOWARD Dytham's brilliant unbeaten 142 put Lullington Park in the driving seat against Wirksworth who battled back to force a draw.

Dytham was thrust into action early — Mervyn Timbrell, a consistent run-getter so far, was bowled on the third ball of the innings — but before the visiting attack could consolidate they were held up by a determined 84-run stand in which Kiwi Garth Littlejohn (39) again impressed.

The third wicket partnership between acting skipper Dave Mudd and Dytham certainly was the game's turning point — they put on 159 runs with a mix of quick singles, hard drives to the boundary and a couple of towering sixes.

Mudd had just completed his half century when dismissed but there was little respite for the attack as Dytham continued to dictate and carried Park to their seasonal best tally of 263-4.

Openers Smedley and Shuttleworth began solidly for the promotion favourites though seamers Mudd and Steve Docker worked hard, eventually breaking through with Littlejohn snapping up a low catch from Smedley.

Teenage seamer Matt Sadler's introduction brought quick rewards, with Shuttleworth caught by Mudd and then Lowe went for a duck.

And it was his spin which broke a stubborn 69-run fourth wicket partnership when Hosein, enticed forward, was smartly stumped by Ian Gray for 44.

Littlejohn then had Woodward caught by Ryan Hetherington and bowled Greatorex, the mainstay of the Wirksworth batting, for 58 as the visitors closed on 193-6. ● PARK'S second innings ended a maximum 27-points haul as they won their Division 4A match away to Muggington by 159 runs.

Dale Clarke set up the victory with a brilliant innings of 125.

And with John Ball (72no) joining the action in equally aggressive fashion, Park were able to declare at 239-4 after 40 overs.

That total was always beyond Muggington's reach as seamers Paul Webb and Dave Finch claimed early wickets and then the impressive Finch continued to wreak havoc, ending with figures of 6-12 in a 15-over stint.

With Pete Green and John Oldfield grabbing wickets towards the close, Muggington were bowled out for 80.

● LULLINGTON'S third string had an easy 10-wicket Division 5B victory over Swarkestone 3rd XI.

Five wickets apiece for Tom Chapman and Richard Allsop, with only Mr Extras reaching double figures, saw the demise of the visitors for only 39.

Danny Green, another of Park's talented youngsters, powered his team to success, needing a little over five overs to score his unbeaten 36, all but four coming in boundaries.

## IT'S SO TIGHT AT THE TOP

**LEADERSHIP of the Burton Tiles second division has changed hands with HOPWAS taking over the top spot after a comfortable win at ELFDORD.**

With two of their batsmen in great form, the visitors lost only three scalps on their way to amassing 231.

John Fearn (85) and Brian Casswell (71no) proved to be the men in form and after tea saw the response demolished, Elford's Lennie Allsop making 35 as his side limped to 111. Stuart Norchi took 5-46 and Phil Rainsford 4-35.

Previous kings of the Division Two castle, TUBURY, lost their unbeaten record at KINGS BROMLEY where the home side posted a 127-run target thanks mainly to David McKenzie's 67 while Jeff Roberts (3-32) enjoyed a profitable spell with the

ball.

But Tubury were not up to matching Bromley's modest effort and were pinned down to 99-9 thanks to Mark Crossland's 4-31 and Dave Birt's 3-9.

BARTON rolled over hosts SWADLINCOTE after hitting a 190-7 total which featured Nigel King top scoring with 38. But the South Derbyshire men must have eaten too much cake at tea for they crumpled to 93 all out, Julian Humpage producing withering figures of 9-40.

And despite a rumbustious 69no from Adam Tomlinson of ROBIRCH PHOENIX his side could only make 165-9 in reply to DRAYCOTT AND HANBURY'S 213-9.

Prime mover Mark Dennis earned richly-deserved pats on the back after his 46 and 4-37 batted and bowled Draycott to victory.

In a high-scoring game at CENTRE SET the home side put on 196-7, skipper Mike James

making 42 while Russ Davenport took 3-45. Visiting TRENTSIDE went for the win after the break but fell 12 runs short after being dismissed for 184 despite John Elson's 72 in the face of Andy Leaver's 3-30 and Brian Fisher's 3-44.

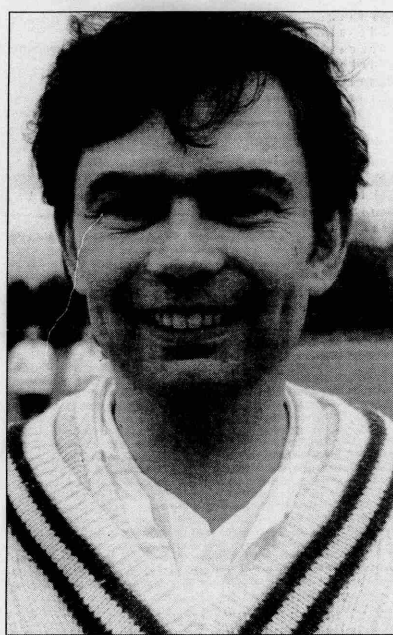
