ROBIRCH Phoenix took another step away from the danger zone with victory at KINGS BROMLEY.

Richard Lightwood cracked 73 not out for the home team but their score of 136-5 proved well within the Burton team's range as Dave Green (67 no) and Adam Tomlinson (48 no) led the charge to a six-wicket win.

League leaders HOPWAS overwhelmed BARTON 2ND as skipper John fearn's fine century helped them amass 224-4. Barton crumbled to 54 all out as Phil Rainsford (5-26) added to his haul of wickets.

CENTRE SET enjoyed an easy win at home to bottom club SWADLINCOTE, who were dismissed for 138 and then found themselves on the receiving end of Brian Fisher's aggressive 86 not out.

ELFORD came off second best to BURTON 2ND who were restricted to 138-9 despite the efforts of Mark Harrison (47).

Brian Found was among the wickets for the villagers but was unable to make his usual healthy combination with the bat as Elford slumped to 111 all out.

TRENTSIDE 2ND suffered a heavy defeat at home to DRAYCOTT & HANBURY 2ND. Simon Ashmore took 6-13 as the home team crashed to 67 all out and even Chris Williams' three wicket haul could prevent a six-wicket rout.

TUTBURY 2ND squeezed home by just 2 runs against IND COOPE 2ND, Andy Fell taking the honours for the Mill team with an impressive 7-53 haul from a marathon stint.

DUNSTALL BACK ON WIN TRAIN

AFTER an enforced absence of three weeks Dunstall returned to action with a deserved victory over Belper Meadows.

After losing the toss Dunstall scored 191-5 and then bowled Belper out for 115 with captain Martin Clewley taking 6-38.

Dunstall began steadily with opening batsmen David Firth and James Benstead looking comfortable against the Belper bowlers until Firth was trapped leg before for 18.

Ian Graves wasted no time in declaring his intentions with a series of early boundaries and with Benstead built a solid platform for Dunstall to attack from in the later stages.

The introduction of Garry Goodhall brought the home side immediate success with Graves dismissed for 34 and in the next over Benstead was bowled by Ernie Fisher for 29 to leave Dunstall 92-3 from 30 overs.

Danny Spasic and Rob Cooper continued to score freely following Belper's double breakthrough, with Cooper next to fall for a typically brisk 25.

Martin Hall joined Spasic for the final over, and the pair added vital extra runs with Hall falling for 20 in the penultimate over and Spasic remaining unbeaten on 47.

Belper began their reply in disastrous fashion when David Jones was caught off Ed Taylor off the bowling of Steve Scrimshaw without scoring.

After a cautious start Belper captain Kevin Hunter and Andy Hosein settled at the crease and shared a 60-run stand to take Belper to 69-2 before a mix up sent Hunter back to the pavilion for 32.

Dunstall soon had the home side further on the rack when Martin Clewley claimed the first of his wickets when he had Chris Parkin caught by Danny Spasic for nought.

Goodhall and Hosein managed to push the score onto 103 without any further loss before Spasic was rewarded

for his consistent line by bowling Goodhall for nine, which also triggered the collapse of the remaining Belper batsmen.

First to depart was Hosein when he was bowled by Clewley for 56. The incoming Belper batsmen continued to struggle against the spin of Clewley, with the Dunstall captain picking up three more wickets in his next three overs, with Raine, Trowell and Alden all failing to survive at the crease for any length of time.

Belper's desperate situation got worse in the remaining overs when David trapped Duncan Wilde lbw for three to leave Tait and Fisher to try and bat out the remaining five overs.

With only four balls remaining Clewley managed to claim the final Belper wicket as Tait was adjudged lbw to leave the home side 115 all out.

Luck runs out on Lullington

LULLINGTON Park were left to count the cost of two early order run outs as they had to settle for a draw in their home Premier Division 2 game with Spondon.

Mervyn Timbrell and Dave Mudd both perished in the quest for quick singles as Park chased a Spondon total of 186-7 and despite a grafting innings from John Davison, Park were struggling at 48-4.

Howard Dymham and Tony Mudd halted the slide with a solid 57 runs fifth-wicket stand, which had the visitors on the defensive as they sensed the game sliding away from them.

However the returning force of seamer Cook produced a double breakthrough and Ian Gray counted himself unfortunate to go to a "catch" to keeper Danvers down the leg-side before Ryan Hetherington and young Andrew Goodwin steered Park to 134-7 and a share of the points.

Earlier, Park's attack had been frustrated after a quick breakthrough but a solid innings of 79 from Skipworth — dropped twice — stood between the sides.

He was supported by Rigg's 29 and 18 from Wakefield as seamer Dave Mudd bit into the

batting by taking 3-49, while Garth Littlejohn's spin also produced a three-wicket haul.
